4 PhD students, 2 Institutions

4 projects examining different aspects of multimorbidity

- Treatment adherence
- Costs to patients
- Link workers and social prescribing
- GP Pharmacist MOP

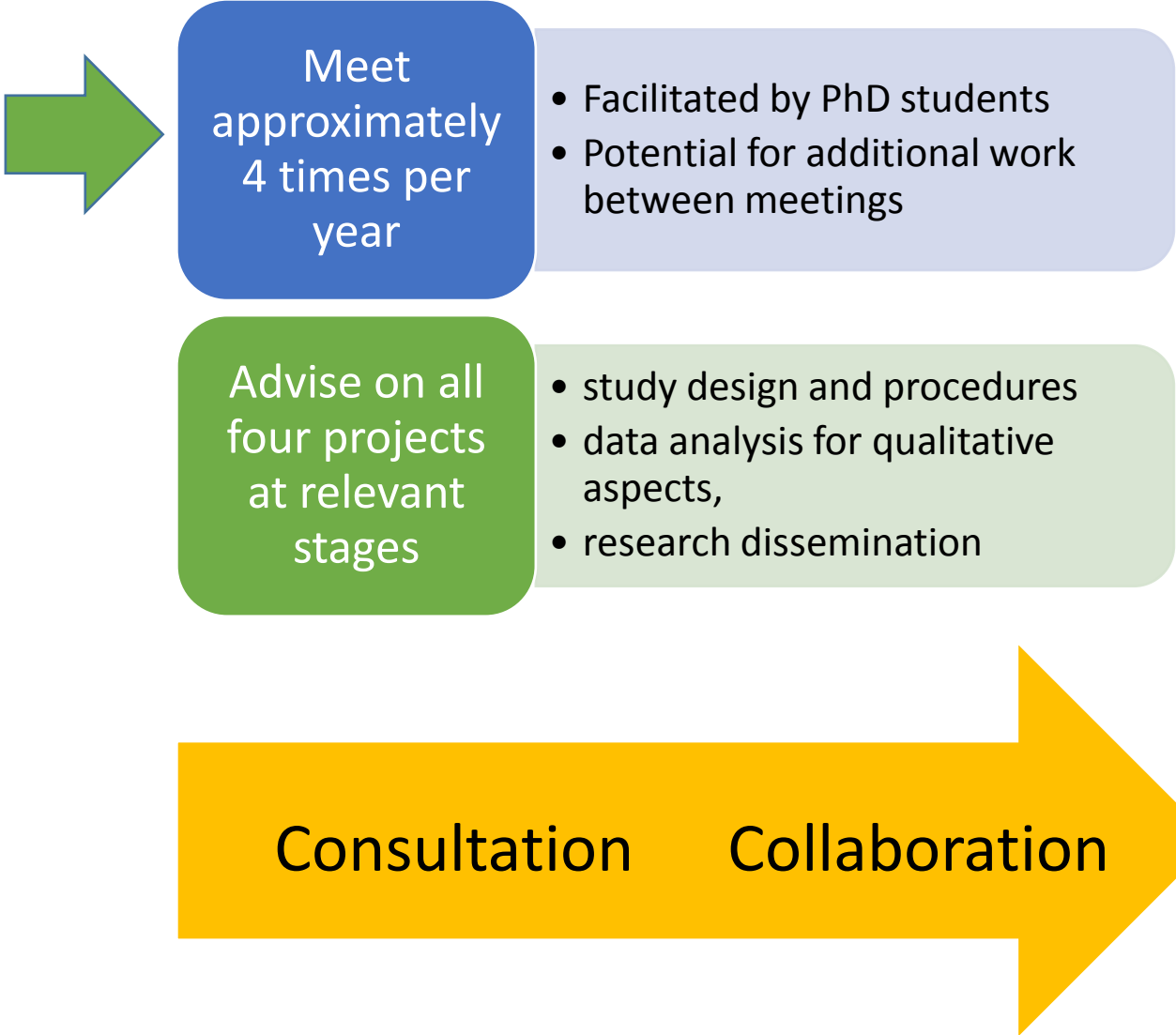
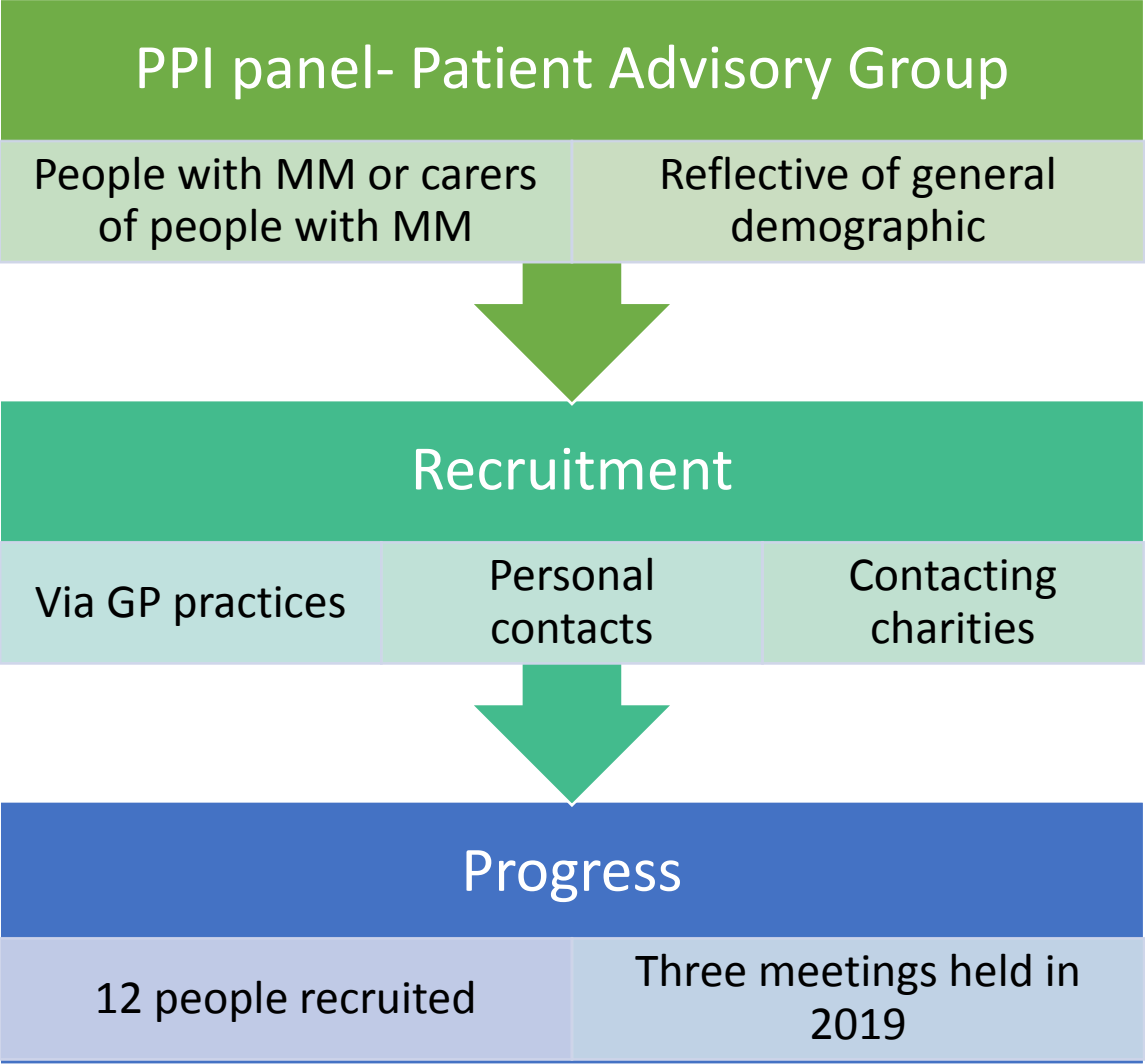
Structured PhD curriculum

- Population health and health services
- Multimorbidity
- PPI

The aim of the collaborative PhD programme is to produce primary care researchers skilled in mixed methods multi-disciplinary research, including practice of PPI

PPI particularly relevant in MM

PPI Approaches/ methodology



Challenges

Risk of overwhelming PPI panel with 4 PhD projects

- Iterative approach project by project or activity by activity

Capacity of panel potentially limited by burden of MM

- 4 meetings per year, any additional work by mutual agreement
- Over recruited

Evaluation of PPI involvement

- Blurring boundaries between involvement and research
- Challenges of evaluation- what to measure and how to measure it?

Recruitment is not same as research

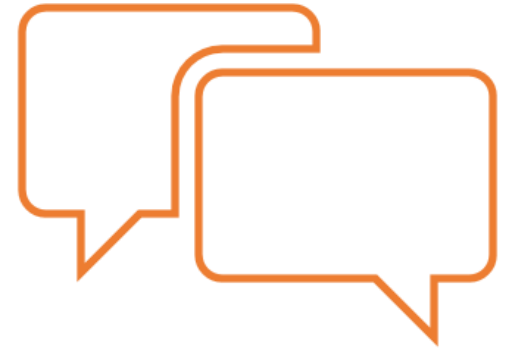
Allow enough funding and time
