

Location & Directions

On foot: Entrance through Blanchardstown Village via Mill Road. Take a right turn after Hospital gates. Pass the main Hospital which you will see on your left. Continue through the roundabout and pass Unit 8 on your right hand side. The GEP building is past the Academic Centre on the right hand side of this road.

By car: Connolly Hospital is accessed via a slip-road directly off the N3 inbound or a right turn off the N3 outbound immediately after the Blanchardstown roundabout (follow the Hospital 'H' signs).

By bus: Routes 38,39 and 70 (from City Centre): Get off the bus at Blanchardstown Village and follow directions as listed above (on foot).

By train: Maynooth line from Connolly Station: Get off the train at Castleknock station. Turn left at the exit and walk along until you see the Bell Pub on your right. Follow instructions 'on foot' as listed above.
