The Health Professions Education Centre is delighted to invite you to a lunchtime session that explores the landscape, benefits and challenges around the use and reuse of Open Educational Resources (OERs) for teaching and learning in Health Professions education.

Open Educational Resources are digitised materials offered freely and openly for educators, students and self-learners to use and reuse for teaching, learning and research (OECD, 2013).





This session will give an overview of the current state of play for Irish Higher Education with a look at the type of OERs that are freely available for use in undergraduate, postgraduate & clinical programmes at RCSI.

OER has emerged as a concept with potential to leverage educational transformation, with positive incentives for academic engagement. While its educational value lies in the idea of using digital resources as a method of supporting self-directed web-based and resource based learning, the transformative power is the ease with which such resources, when digitised, can be discovered, used, and reused in a particular learning context – which raises the issue of the pedagogical relationship between the learner and the educator – and their role as curator of the educational experience.
